"Your diapers have brought many more people to our doors, we've been able to help more Latinx clients due to your diapers."


"Having a supply of diapers to offer residents helps them have funds to use towards other family needs."

"Providing diapers allows me to gain the trust of a family and connect them to other services that can help stabilize them."


